4. Unfinished Business and General Orders

4.1 Mar Vista Kids Zoo – No live animals.

Animals will be made from arts/crafts and materials available at home. We are taking suggestions to change the name from "Kids Zoo". Currently we have one suggestion: Mar Vista Menagerie.

Discussed coordinating the event with the Mar Vista Park & Rec Center. (Elisa White – Rec Center Recreation Coordinator was in attendance) The MV Park & Rec Center is happy to collaborate and will look towards using it as their Summer Camp Extravaganza. They will have the summer camp children work on animals throughout the summer. MV Park & Rec Center will provide the supplies for the camp children. Summer camp runs from 6/22 – 8/14. We anticipate the MV zoo/menagerie will take place the weekend of August 14th – 16th exact dates to follow. The animals will be placed around the perimeter of the Mar Vista Park. The MV Park & Rec Center will publicize the event. We do not anticipate any fees/charges or expenses to be paid by the MVCC or EACC. We will be able to store the animals overnight at the MV Park & Rec Center.

5. New Business

5.1 Pop up/Neighborhood concert - Discussed including Pop-up concert as an option for the zoo/menagerie. Need to discuss in more detail.

5.2 Chalk Art – Discussed including chalk art as an option at the zoo/menagerie. Suggestion to tape off the basketball courts with social distance sections. Elissa White made a motion to include chalk art at the zoo/menagerie. Second to the motion by Gabriel Hill. Motion passed by a unanimous vote.
