PURPOSE: Board & Community Support of Historic FS 62 - Bill Rosendahl Community Center

**BACKGROUND:**

Historic Fire 62/ Bill Rosendahl Community Center is looking to partner with Crash Space to bring a Community Center to Mar Vista at the Historic FS 62 located on Centinela and Windward.

Crash Space is a 501(c3) They have a large number of folks who've made their money in Tech and are looking for ways to grow/connect Crash Space into the community in more significant ways. CRASH Space is a non-profit organization located in Los Angeles and run by volunteers. Founded in 2009, it is a part of the growing global hackerspace movement. A collection of hackers, programmers, builders, makers, and artists. Promoting science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEAM) by teaching classes, participating in events, providing on-line resources, and by running a shared workshop.

This collaboration would dedicate about 50% of the Fire Station to their dedicated use.

Historic Fire 62/ Bill Rosendahl Community Center:

- Renovations would turn facility into a multi purpose space (inside as well as the parking lot)
- Potential for lectures, events, community work from space

Construction for the center is estimated at 2 million, 1 million contribution by Crash Space would make this project much more possible.
