Your communication of November 26, 2005, regarding resurfacing funding for Neighborhood Councils was received by the Bureau of Street Services for review and response.


All of the resurfacing funds allocated for the Neighborhood Council during the 2005-2006 Fiscal Year have been expended. The following projects were completed using the \$100,000 allocated for the Mar Vista Neighborhood Council:

- Ellenda Avenue, Queensland Street to Kingsland Street
- Ellenda Place, Ellenda Avenue to Kelton Avenue
- Glendon Avenue, Westwood Boulevard to Queensland Street
- Malcolm Avenue, Queensland Street to dead end south of Kingsland Street
- Selby Avenue, Queensland Street to dead end south of Queensland Street
- Pearl Place, Coolidge Avenue to Barry Avenue

Resurfacing funds were not allocated for Neighborhood Councils for the current 2006-2007 Fiscal Year. Your understanding in this matter is greatly appreciated.
