4. Unfinished Business and General Orders

4.1 EACC Outreach to Schools

a. Coordinate with local schools- send liaisons to Booster/PTA meetings

We need updated contact lists for all local schools. Discussed NPG applications and how the schools can use them. If it's an LAUSD budget item, MVCC cannot approve the NPG. Options for bus rentals and community Demonstration of Knowledge showcases.

b. Space Camp scholarship outreach for students ages 10-15

Space Camp Turkey is a summer camp for students ages 10-15. They are offering scholarships which cover the full 10 day camp (airfare not included). EACC is looking for locations, including schools, libraries, and park recreation rooms that would be interested in hosting an informational session in November. The MVCC Outreach Committee has ideas about getting the word out.
