- 1. CALL TO ORDER 6:30pm Kathryn Wheeler, Outreach Chair; Mary Hruska, Zone 3 Director, Secretary; Holly Tilson, Zone 6 Director, Treasurer; Stakeholders: David Lee, Elizabeth Sharma, Faith Myhra, and Wayne Wheeler.

- 3. READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES
 - **3.1.** JANUARY 25, 2021 Ms. Hruska made a motion to approve the minutes, it was seconded by Ms. Tilson, and approved without objection.
- 4. Report None
- 5. STANDARD ORDER OF BUSINESS (60 MINUTES)
 - 5.1. NEW BUSINESS FUNDING MOTIONS (require allocations of funds)
 - 5.1.1. Discussion and possible action regarding an expenditure not to exceed \$14,000 for costs pertaining to an election mailing or newsletter. The coding for a mailing list was completed today and an estimate was provided of \$12,707.49 for mailing a 6.125" x 11.5" double-sided color postcard to the 23,990 "Current Residents" inside Mar Vista. This includes single and multi-family units, trailers, and businesses. An 8-page newsletter would be \$6,481.52; 12-page would be \$8,635.71; 16-page would be \$9,928.23. Questions regarding the timeline, translations, and distribution (especially among our unhoused) were discussed. A motion was made to approve the motion by David Lee, seconded by Faith Myhra, and passed without objection.
- **6. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS (5 MINUTES)** The next meeting will entail the design of either a postcard for mailing or a newsletter.

- 7. PUBLIC COMMENTS/CONCERNS Stakeholders raised concern regarding reaching the unhoused during the election. Ms. Wheeler is attending a February 24 Homeless Outreach Election meeting and will inquire as how the Mar Vista unhoused are going to be reached and will email attending stakeholders the answer and/or mention the information at the March 25 Outreach meeting.
- **8. ANNOUNCEMENTS -** The March Outreach meeting will be held on the 4th Thursday instead of the 3rd to allow designing time for either a postcard or a newsletter.
