Pay It Forward – Create A Circle of Giving

- Time Credits
 - TimeBank services traded for Time Credits
 - One hour given = One Time Credit earned
 - Spend Time Credits to receive services from others

TimeBank coordinator/leadership team

- Manages TimeBank admin. duties
- Signs up members, organizes events, outreach
- Leads funding efforts
- Encourages member engagement

- Search offers/wants for ways to participate
- Members record completed exchanges
- Community Forge keeps track
