Allow NCs to Communicate with Elected Officials Outside of City Council

Wherefore, the Mar Vista Community Council represents stakeholders within their boundaries regarding all issues involving but not limited to quality of life, zoning, land use, public safety, mobility, arts and education, aging in place and communications involving State and City matters. Elected officials from the City, County and State regularly send representatives to our meetings to inform, educate and seek information from our stakeholders and council concerning legislation and initiatives. Open dialogue is essential with ALL elected officials to ensure that our stakeholders are fully represented and have a voice in matters that concern them.

Therefore, RESOLVED that the Mar Vista Community Council insists that Neighborhood Councils are not prohibited from communicating with non-City of Los Angeles government representatives and/or staff not with entities other than those within the City, regarding issues impacting their neighborhoods; and that Neighborhood Councils are free to discuss any issues of local concern.
