TITLE: Add Wasatch Ave to Next Resurfacing Schedule

PURPOSE: To ask that the 3500 Block of Wasatch Ave be added to the next resurfacing schedule as it is in extensive disrepair and has had repaving requests regularly submitted by a stakeholder for over 20 years.

BACKGROUND: As the pictures demonstrate, the 3500 Block of Wasatch Ave Mar-Vista (Between Westminster Ave and Windward Ave) is in extensive disrepair. The edges of the asphalt from the skip coat are crumbling and causing water build up and the drainage setup is causing pools of water to collect at various driveways. In addition there are large pot-holes, cracks, and a patch work of asphalt patching. This issue was brought to the MVCC's Transportation, Infrastructure, & Sustainability committee by a stakeholder named Angelo Pacifici, who has been making repaving requests for this street to the city for over 20 years.

THE MOTION: The MVCC is FOR adding 3500 Block of Wasatch Ave to the next resurfacing schedule for the Street Renewal Division of the Bureau of Street Services.
