
LADWP Green Power Plan

Where Does Our Power Come From?

- LADWP owns some energy production infrastructure such as power plants, solar farms, and other types.
- The infrastructure it owns is not enough to produce power for all customers, so LADWP also purchases power from private power plants, solar farms, wind farms, etc.
- LADWP is investing in building more renewable energy infrastructure, with the goal to achieve net zero emissions by 2035.




How Does the Green Power Plan Work?

- You the consumer agree to pay an extra \$0.03 per kWh of power used, for a certain percentage of your bill (minimum 20%).
 - Currently, a kWh costs about \$0.20. This price goes up if you use over a certain amount of electricity.
- LADWP then purchases that percentage of the power you use from renewable sources only (last year it was all solar).
- The more people participate, the more demand there is for renewable energy, leading to more renewable generation investment.
 - Over time, energy from renewable sources will eventually become cheaper than fossil fuel generation with enough investment.

How It Looks on Your Bill

In Summary

- Currently less than 1% of LADWP customers are enrolled in the program. This is a very easy way for those with more money to fight climate change directly.
- Committing to 100% green energy increases your energy bill by a maximum of 14%. The more power you use, the less of a percentage increase it is.
- Committing to 20% green energy increases your bill by just around 3%.
