POSITION: SUPPORT

<u>THE MOTION:</u> The Mar Vista Community Council <u>supports</u> that LADWP study, report on, and expedite approval of new technologies, such as meter socket adaptors, which can help the City reach its energy policy goals.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The <u>LA 100 plan</u> mandates that the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power achieve 100% carbon-free electricity by 2035, an ambitious clean energy goal. However, the department's approval policies for adopting new, potentially helpful technologies are both slow and opaque. For example, the meter socket adaptor is an invention that may make some expensive residential upgrades unnecessary and improve electrical resilience, though there may be some risks to consumers. LADWP's current approval process for such technologies are not currently quick and transparent enough to meet our LA 100 goals.
