- The motion requires that the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power be INSTRUCTED to report back with a current map of all undergrounded and aboveground utilities in Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zones.
- The motion also requires that the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, with the assistance of any needed department or government agency, be INSTRUCTED to report back on the feasibility and implementation of a tiered system for undergrounding powerlines.
