4) Please describe the purpose and intent of the grant.

Beautify LA will provide shelter rides, hygiene kits, and food to the homeless men and woman of Mar Vista Neighborhood through Midnight Mission and World Harvest. We will supplement the neighborhood with eight trash and graffiti cleanups with resources from Beautify LA, Community of Beautification (COB) and 311 app provided by the City of Los Angeles. We will plant a garden with environmentally sustainable flowers, bushes, and trees (the trees are free with City Plants a partner with LADWP) with permission from the city by obtaining a permit. Beautify LA will host two art events and one gardening event. The art events would consist of painting a canvas led by a teacher (similar to Bob Ross) and the gardening event will educate and teach how to plant roses and strawberries; and provide gardening kits for participants to take home for free. The events are for all ages.


5) How will this grant be used to primarily support or serve a public purpose and benefit the public at-large. (Grants cannot be used as rewards or prizes for individuals)

Beautify LA will support unhoused people with shelter, hygiene kits, and food through partnerships. Eight trash and graffiti cleanups will take place from August 2025 to June 2026. We will begin the process to plant a garden in collaboration with this council and the city. We will donate \$1,000 worth of flowers and bushes, the trees are free, to the garden. The events will be supported by Beautify LA and Parks & Recs. These initiatives will touch hundreds of lives through seeing additional cleaning efforts in the neighborhood to asking a friend to join you at an art event at the local park. We will support the public at-large. This will create a good feeling for residents when they see homeless people receiving the care they need. Trash cleanups will promote a healthier environment and discourage litter; events will promote community engagement and foster civic pride.
