

DIRECTOR'S REPORT - ZONE 6

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1. A stakeholder reported that vines are encroaching over the whale mural on the east exterior wall of the DCRC located at the corner of Beethoven and Venice. Application submitted for this to be a ShineLA cleanup event; other options possible. (new)
2. Stakeholders met with Matthew Halden (CD-11/Traci Park field rep for Mar Vista) online to discuss three trees on Warren Avenue selected for removal by Bureau of Street Services to repair the road damaged by their roots. Public hearing has not yet been scheduled. Stakeholders are upset about healthy tree removal, and seeking other options and more information. Due to litigation against the city from a 2020 accident, the city must act. (ongoing since 2024)
3. Stakeholders continue to report code violations at Beethoven Market at Palms and Beethoven. The city confirms violations and is considering penalties. (ongoing since opening March 2025)
4. Artist Lori Powers has installed six new sculptures, five in Zone 6 along Palms, Maplewood, and Marco. Her whimsical creatures used to hang off LADWP poles, but were removed due to lawful prohibitions. The new ones are up now on independent poles and private property, e.g., front yards. (new)
