Community Benefits & Safeguards

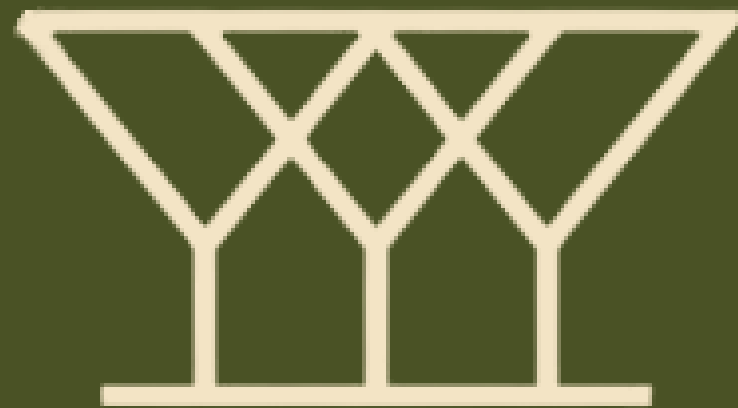
