TITLE: Removal of Flock Cameras in Mar Vista

COMMITTEE: Transportation, Infrastructure, and Sustainability (TI&S) Committee

POSITION: Flock Cameras should be removed.

THE MOTION: The MVCC directs the following letter to Councilmember Park of CD11. "The MVCC does not support the installation of Flock Cameras in Mar Vista. Please cease all further installations of these devices and remove all cameras already installed."

BACKGROUND:

- Automated license plate readers, or Flock Cameras, [are being installed in Mar Vista](#) as a crime prevention measure through increased surveillance. These cameras passively monitor the passage of cars through the neighborhood and record the movements of residents.
- A report by the University of Washington Center for Human Rights, attached in supporting documents, describes how this data is used by federal agencies to track local residents.
- Reporting has shown that [Flock data is used by immigration authorities](#) in violation of California state law.
- While there are legitimate law enforcement applications for ALPR technology, the threat of abuse is too high to justify its implementation at this time.
