

## **ADMINISTRATIVE MOTION**

**COMMITTEE:** Town Hall Planning (an Ad Hoc Committee)

**TITLE:** Preliminary Report, Discussion, Request for Approval of Further Action

### **BACKGROUND:**

In November, 2025, the MVCC created an ad hoc committee to plan a town hall meeting between the MVCC and stakeholders. The committee was led by Director Vanek, with additional members 2nd Vice-chair Marton and Director Paddock. As an ad hoc committee consisting solely of three board members, Brown Act regulations for meetings are not applicable.

The committee has met multiple times and drafted a proposal to host a town hall that is:

- Free and open to the public
- Occurring on a Saturday or Sunday in October 2026
- Approximately three hours in length
- Structured to feature:
  - An introductory presentation and concluding remarks by the full MVCC board
  - Multiple breakout sessions where stakeholders can meet and discuss with each MVCC committee
  - Opportunities for stakeholders to meet their neighbors through common interests and/or location, i.e., their zone affiliation

There are options between two venues and the cost to the MVCC, ranging from \$0 (zero) to roughly \$2000, depending on variables such as the venue, refreshments, livestreaming, swag, marketing and outreach, etc. *Any funding for this town hall event would be assigned to the MVCC 2026-27 fiscal year budget, which begins July 1 2026.*

### **THE MOTION:**

The MVCC approves the continuation of the town hall ad hoc committee and its work planning for a 2026 town hall event. This does not constitute final approval of the town hall event, only the continued work in planning it.
