Beethoven Market's RBP was terminated due to non-compliance on December 18 2025 see ADM-2024-8010-RBPA. The market is requesting a new license to serve alcohol application dated 3/23/2026 LACP ZA-2026-1432-CUB.

On December of 2024 The Certificate of Occupancy was issued for a restaurant located at 12904 Palms, The restaurant is categorized as A-2 Occupancy with an interior maximum of 129 occupants. A 935-square-foot Private Dining Patio. No parking was required.

Limited hours of operation, from 7 AM through 11 PM.
