1. Warren Ave road repaving project continues

On Monday May 18, the project to repave Warren Avenue began. Dead trees and three mature but healthy trees were removed. Gutters and sidewalks are being worked on. Different crews are rotating for the different stages of the road repair. This might take up to another month to complete.

2. I was happy to meet, however briefly, with Mar Vista Neighbors, a group—mostly located on Dewey and nearby homes—focused on having a voice on the future choices of the Santa Monica Airport. Thanks to Frank for opening up his home and the stakeholders who attended the presentation from Peter James (SM Deputy City Manager) and Amber Richane (City of Santa Monica's lead on the airport conversion project) with Sean Silva from CD11 Councilwoman Traci Park's office also attending.

3. Watch out for coyotes, especially if you have outdoor pets!

Coyote Awareness And Safety Information – Coyotes have been part of Southern California's landscape for thousands of years, and every spring, we tend to see more activity as they search for food and care for their young.
