Application Deadline: All stakeholders interested in voting by mail in a Neighborhood Council Election must complete a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) application to identify your status(es) as a stakeholder. In order to receive your VBM ballot, submit a completed application and any required documentation, to the City Clerk's Office 19 days prior to the specific Neighborhood **Council Election Day.** VBM Applications that lack the applicant's signature, or which do not include required information/documentation necessary to establish stakeholder eligibility, will not be processed. Some of the information on the VBM application may be subject to the California Public Records Act request.

The Mar Vista Community Council is composed of 15 elected Mar Vista stakeholders, all of which are up for election every two years. The election is conducted by the Los Angeles City Clerk's Office. You may vote In-Person or Vote-by-Mail. There will be no ballot drop box.

### **MVCC IS PART OF NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCILS**

Neighborhood Councils (NC) is a citywide system created in 1999 with the hope of putting individuals back in charge of the government. Its stated and chartered purpose is, "To promote more citizen participation in government and make government more responsive to local needs." The NC design combines aspects of citizens, volunteers, and elected officials.

### ALL ELIGIBLE STAKEHOLDERS AND COMMUNITY INTEREST STAKEHOLDERS MAY VOTE IN THE MVCC NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL ELECTION WITH PROOF OF AGE, RESIDENCY, AND STAKEHOLDER STATUS

### WHAT IS A STAKEHOLDER?

"Stakeholder" is defined as an individual who lives, works, or owns real property within the boundaries of the Mar Vista Community Council; also known as MVCC.

#### OR

is a Community Interest Stakeholder, i.e., member of or participates in a Community Organization within the boundaries of the MVCC.

A "Community Organization" is an entity that has continuously maintained a physical street address within the boundaries of the MVCC for not less than one year, and that performs ongoing and verifiable activities and operations that confer some benefit on the community within the boundaries of the MVCC.

#### A FOR PROFIT ENTITY SHALL NOT QUALIFY AS A **COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION.**

Examples of Community Organizations may include Chambers of Commerce, houses of worship or other faith-based organizations, educational institutions, or non-profit organizations.

All stakeholders, must specify a qualifying address or location within the MVCC boundaries to participate. Stakeholder claims cannot be based on participation occurring outside of the MVCC boundaries.

# **TO VOTE IN PERSON**

### If you choose to vote in person, you DO NOT need to apply for a

ballot. Just bring proof of age, residence and stakeholder status with you to the Mar Vista Recreation Center on March 26th, 2023, and you will receive a ballot on site and proceed to vote.



Polling hours: 1-7pm, March 26, 2023. Voters who are still in line when the polls close on Election Day will be allowed to vote.



Curbside voting will be available to voters with disabilities who are unable to access the polling place. Poll workers will be available to assist Curbside Voters with the voter registration process and ensure that their ballots are properly cast.

## TO VOTE **BY MAIL**

Unlike national or state elections, all Vote-by-Mail (VBM) voters in any NC election must request a ballot each election via the VBM application (page 4).



- City Clerk mails ballots after verifying Voter eligibility.
- Ballot mailings begin Feb. 19, 2023 and ends March 7 2023, Call 213-978-0444 if not received.
- Completed ballot must be postmarked no later than March 26 and received by April 5, 2023, OR dropped off March 26th at the Mar Vista Rec Center.

### YOU MUST APPLY FOR A BALLOT BY MARCH 7, 2023.

### **DOCUMENTS YOU WILL NEED**

All applications must have documentation that proves eligibility to vote. Documentation submitted will not be retained. In general, documentation consists of the following:



1. Photo ID Examples: Driver's license, state ID card, passport, or picture ID with name of work, school, etc.

2. Proof of age Examples: Driver's

license, state ID card, passport, or birth certificate

#### 3. Proof of residence, property ownership, or employment Examples: Driver's license, state ID card, current utility bill, insurance documents, property tax bill, current rental receipt, property deed, lease/rental agreement, letter from landlord confirming renter/tenant status, mortgage statement, pay check or pay stub, work permit, property deed.

#### OR

3. Proof of Community Interest Examples: Membership card, receipt of membership dues, letter from school, church, or organization. Letter must be on organization's letterhead and include the following to be valid: Date; statement that organization is non-profit and the representative's original signature, full printed name, title, contact information; physical address of the organization that has been continuously maintained no less than one year within the MVCC's boundaries-name of stakeholder, relationship to establishment, duration of participation and organization considers stakeholder to be a substantial and ongoing participant.
