

Update below from Culver City on the Stormwater project.

"The City went back to a redesign of the project. The larger underground chamber, originally designed on Washington Boulevard between Glencoe and Redwood, will now be constructed on Glencoe Avenue, north of Washington on the western side of the parking lane and sidewalk. (Costco side). All 88 parking spaces along Washington Boulevard that were originally planned to be removed during construction, will not be impacted with the new design. A smaller chamber will be constructed on Washington in the median between the two Costco driveway entrances. Traffic patterns have been adjusted. Westbound Washington will have accessibility to turn southbound onto Glencoe as is the current pattern. North bound Glencoe will have accessibility to turn westbound onto Washington as well as enter the Costco driveway.

Our timeline is to complete design by the end of this month and draft bid specifications to be published by mid-October 2020. We are hoping to award construction contract in January 2021 with construction anticipated to begin in March 2021. The project is anticipated to be completed within one year with the majority of the work being constructed on Glencoe, north of Washington."
