Update on the Mosaic Hopscotch project long planned for placement at the MV Library area STATUS: Meetings took place in April 2019 with CD11's Hannah Levien, mosaic artist Tracey Corinne, MVCC's Michelle Krupkin and Bureau of Street Services Supervisor Larry Hresko. The City of LA Cultural Affairs Commission approved the project at their 11/13/19 monthly hearing. Waiting for paperwork and update from CD11 and BoSS/StreetsLA. The mosaic materials passed a BOE slip test 3/4/20. Prior to COVID-19 shutdown, installation was targeted for April 2020 or later. STATUS: 1/08/21 Public Works meeting took place and Encroachment in Public Right-Of-Way permits were approved. Additional meeting with Tracey, BSS/StreetsLA took place week of 1/11/21 in which city clarified that it will remove two of the sidewalk slabs from expansion joint to expansion joint. They will then pour a platform base for the mosaic. Awaiting further update from Tracey regarding a possible May 2021 installation target date as well as details and coordination with StreetsLA.

CIS letter delivery pending.
 - d. Motion regarding Traffic Data Request for Great Streets Venice Bld. Project. The MVCC requests that LADOT, CD11 and the Mayor's Great Street Office release year 2 traffic, bike and accident data regarding Great Street Venice Blvd. and reinstate the www.VeniceBoulevardMarVista.org website **STATUS**: PASSED at 3/10/20 Board of Directors Agenda.
