THE MVCC OPPOSES COUNCIL FILE 21-0863 UNLESS THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET:

 - 1. HOUSING SUBSIDIES PAID FOR BY TAXPAYERS OF LOS ANGELES SHOULD NOT BE PROVIDED TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARRIVED IN LOS ANGELES IN THE PAST 36 MONTHS.**
 - 2. SUPPORTIVE HOUSING FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH SERIOUS MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES SHOULD NOT BE LOCATED IN RESIDENTIAL NEIGHBORHOODS WITH CHILDREN AND SCHOOLS WITHIN 1000FT.**
 - 3. DRUG ADDICTION TREATMENT SHOULD BE REQUIRED FOR ANY INDIVIDUALS WITH DRUG ADDICTION IN ORDER TO RECEIVE TAX-PAYER SUBSIDIZED HOUSING.**

The MVCC is an advisory board to the Los Angeles City council and, as such, its***
