**Upcoming And/Or Ongoing LADWP Contract Negotiations:** Re:

Dear Councilmembers:

At the regularly scheduled meeting held September 10, 2013, The Mar Vista Community Council approved the following policy motion by a vote of 12-0-1:

The MVCC supports the following recommendations to the Mayor and City Council for their upcoming and/or ongoing LADWP contract negotiations:

- The MVCC supports ongoing reform in LADWP policy to reduce the overall bonus/overtime amount that LADWP employees are currently receiving.
- The MVCC supports a termination of the clause requiring increases in LADWP employee pay when outside private contractors are called in to perform necessary water/power infrastructure maintenance, installation, customer service or construction.
- The MVCC opposes any LADWP labor action (such as a strike) that would threaten the construction, maintenance or operation of any water/power City infrastructure.

The MVCC supports full disclosure of City Budget impacts relative to the proposed contract.
