"The Mar Vista Community Council hereby sets aside and encumbers funds not to exceed \$11,321.00 from its FY 2011-2012 budget allocation for FY 2012-2013, commencing July 1, 2012, for the specific purpose of Neighborhood Council Elections outreach to the community in the form of:

1000 Postcards color one side--\$226.00 [includes sales tax and shipping]. Vendor: Modern Postcards

Copies/forms--\$300.00. Vendor: Office Depot
